Remarks

- Class Fees should be put into labeled envelopes and turned in to Scoutmaster upon leaving if not paid for in advance.
- Everything should be in non-aerosol cans.
- Everything should be packed in a plastic footlocker. A lock will be needed for footlocker, upon leaving provide Scoutmaster with combination or additional key.
- EVERYTHING should be labeled with a permanent marker.
- No electronic games, cell phones, Ipods etc. (leave expensive electronics at home)
- Some parents find it helpful to split up clothing into daily outfits and place each in its own large ziplock bag.
- Another tip is to divide spending money by day and place each day in its own sealed envelope.
- If your scout will be taking prescription medication, PLEASE provide a permission slip and reason for the medication. Medication must be stored in the original bottle.
